PUBLIC QUESTIONS

Resident: Caxton has submitted application on behalf of the garage owners for trees on a third parties land to be felled. The agents diagram is inaccurate regarding positioning of trees

Resident: An application was made to maintain trees 2002 and the work was carried out. An application has been submitted by a third party to fell the trees. Very few trees in the vicinity. These trees are important for aesthetics and for wildlife. The garages only date from 1960's and it is unlikely they would meet today's building standards.

Resident: The diagram of the proposed roundabout on the Ashford Road shows only half of the roundabout. It is therefore not possible to consider its exact position, design and capacity.

County Clir A Hook: Confirms that Kent County Council is still modelling the new roundabout. He will ask of a diagram of the proposed roundabout is available.

Resident: Informed that meeting that he had spoken to Kevin Bell at Highways England concerning J6, which they consider to be a "Hotspot". Improvements to the junction should be considered before new developments add further pressure to the overstrained infrastructure,

The proposed Preston Fields entrance is too close to junction of A2 and A251.

Resident: Raised several concerns about proposed development at Preston Fields:

- 1) The site should be used to extract brick earth, safeguarding brick manufacture in local area
- 2) Proposed new access onto A2 lacks information.
- 3) Insufficient information concerning bus stops for the proposed development
- 4) Insufficient and misleading information regarding existing accesses to Ambulance Station, Kent County Council Highways Deport and Traditional Building Supplies.
