**6. Amendment of Traffic Order for various roads in Faversham**

The Town Council considered the amendment to (Various Roads, Faversham, Borough of Swale) (Traffic Regulation) Order 2018.

**Recommendation :Support with following amendments.**

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1i) COURT STREET

In order to be consistent with the One-Way current direction status; and subsequent descriptions:

From the junction with Crescent Road to the junction with Market Place  
3ii) MARKET PLACE (both arms); south eastwards towards Market Street. "  
3iii) MARKET STREET; south eastwards towards Preston Street. "

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9) TABLE

Market Place (both arms), south eastwards towards Market Street

Market Street south eastwards towards Preston Street

Preston Street between its junction with East Street and its junction with Stone Street south towards Stone Street

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FIRST SCHEDULE Court Street, Faversham, From its junction with Crescent Road to the junction with Market Place

SECOND SCHEDULE East Street, Faversham, From its junction with Newton Road to the junction with Market Street and Preston Street.

Preston Street, Faversham, From its junction with Market Street and East Street to the junction with Stone Street.

### **7. Cleve Hill Solar Park**

It was proposed by Cllr Belsom, seconded by Cllr Wade and on being put to the meeting it was ***RESOLVED that Faversham Town Council should form a working party to consider the Cleve Hill Solar Park Application.***
