**1. THE KENT NATURE PARTNERSHIP BIODIVERSITY STRATEGY 2019-2044**

The Kent Biodiversity Strategy sets out the contribution the county of Kent, and the Kent Nature Partnership, can make to the Government's ambition to leave our environment in a better state than we found it and the aspirations set out in its 25 Year Environment Plan "A Green Future".

It is recommended that this is delegated to the Climate and Biodiversity Committee to respond.

**3. CAR PARKING SUPPLEMENTARY PLANNING DOCUMENT**

This document aims to bring forward a localised car parking standard regime for the whole of Swale, with the aim of establishing a more appropriate and effective response to parking issues relating to new development across the Borough, noting the likely different character typology areas within it – including central/suburban/rural locations.
