

AT A MEETING OF FAVERSHAM TOWN COUNCIL PLANNING COMMITTEE held at The Guildhall, Faversham, on Monday, 9th March 2020.

1. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies were received from Cllrs K Barker, J Irwin and E Thomas. It was proposed by the Mayor, Cllr Mrs A Reynolds and, on being put to the meeting, it was:

2. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

There were no declarations of interest.

3. MINUTES

It was proposed by Cllr J Saunders, seconded by Cllr T Martin and on being put to the meeting it was ***RESOLVED to approve the Minutes of the Meeting of Faversham Town Council Planning Committee held on 24th February 2020.***

4. PLANNING SCHEDULE

The Planning Schedule dated 24th February 2020 was noted.

The Notification of Planning Decisions dated 9th March 2020 was noted

6. PLANNING APPLICATIONS

It was: ***RESOLVED that recommendations be sent to Kent County Council (Kent County Council) and Swale Borough Council (SBC) as set out in Planning Schedule 9th March 2020***

7. STREET AND FLAT NAMES FOR 2ND PHASE OF THE BRICKWORKS SITE

The Meeting discussed the names suggested for the 2nd phase of the Brickworks site, Austin, Cornelius, Feaver, Filmer, Gates, Holness, Jordan, Pordage, Reynolds, Snoad, Tassell and Wise.

Whilst it was noted that the names had been selected from the Borough of Faversham Burgess Roll of November 1907, concerns were raised that a number of these names were still in wide use. It was concluded that if selected some of the names could be wrongly connected to people in the town today.

The meeting continued that it had liked the names suggested for the first phase (Breeze, Bond, Brickearth, Flattie, Lamb, Moulder, Pryer, Pugmill, Pysing and Stock) as they reflected the history of the site.

The Town Council concluded that they would welcome names suggestions for the second phase that also reflected that history of the site.

The meeting closed at 6.26pm.

PUBLIC QUESTIONS

Mr C Oswald- Jones asked if the names suggested for the 2nd phase of the Brickworks site met the criteria that names should not be used until 50 years after the person they were recollecting had passed away.

Mr F Macdonald stated that names being considered had been drawn from the Borough of Faversham Burgess Roll of November 1907.
