The Mall, Faversham
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER JANUARY 2021

To allow ducting works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of The Mall, Faversham.

A closure is planned from 25th January 2021, between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30, with estimated completion by 29th January 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC31700000000096226FC-1 - BT). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

The Mall will be closed from outside number 34 to outside number 14, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while ducting works are undertaken by BT.

There is no alternative route for this closure, due to the road being a dead-end. However, residential access will be maintained at all times, when it is safe to do so.
