## (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

## **TEMPORARY ORDER FEBRUARY 2021**

To allow tree surgery works to be carried out to hang over head fibre, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on Elverton Lane & Wildmarsh Road, Luddenham.


A closure is planned from 8th February 2021, with estimated completion by 12th February 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC111WAQUPJ3M008 - BT). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on <a href="One.Network">One.Network</a>

Elverton Lane & Wildmarsh Road will be closed from the junction with Lower Road to outside Elverton Bungalow, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while tree surgery to hang overhead fibre are undertaken by BT.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Wildmarsh Road, Luddenham Hill, Bysing Wood Road, Lower Road and vice versa.
