THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER FEBRUARY 2021

To allow water main connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Faversham Road, Ospringe.


A closure is planned from 1st February 2021, with estimated completion by 5th February 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (EB006-25271370 - South East Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Faversham Road will be closed in the general vicinity of Malder's Shave, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while water main connection works are undertaken by South East Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Faversham Road, The Street, Doddington Lane, Chequers Hill, Christophers Row, Lynsted Lane, A2 London Road and vice versa.
