THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER FEBRUARY 2021

To allow clearance works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Brent Hill, Faversham.

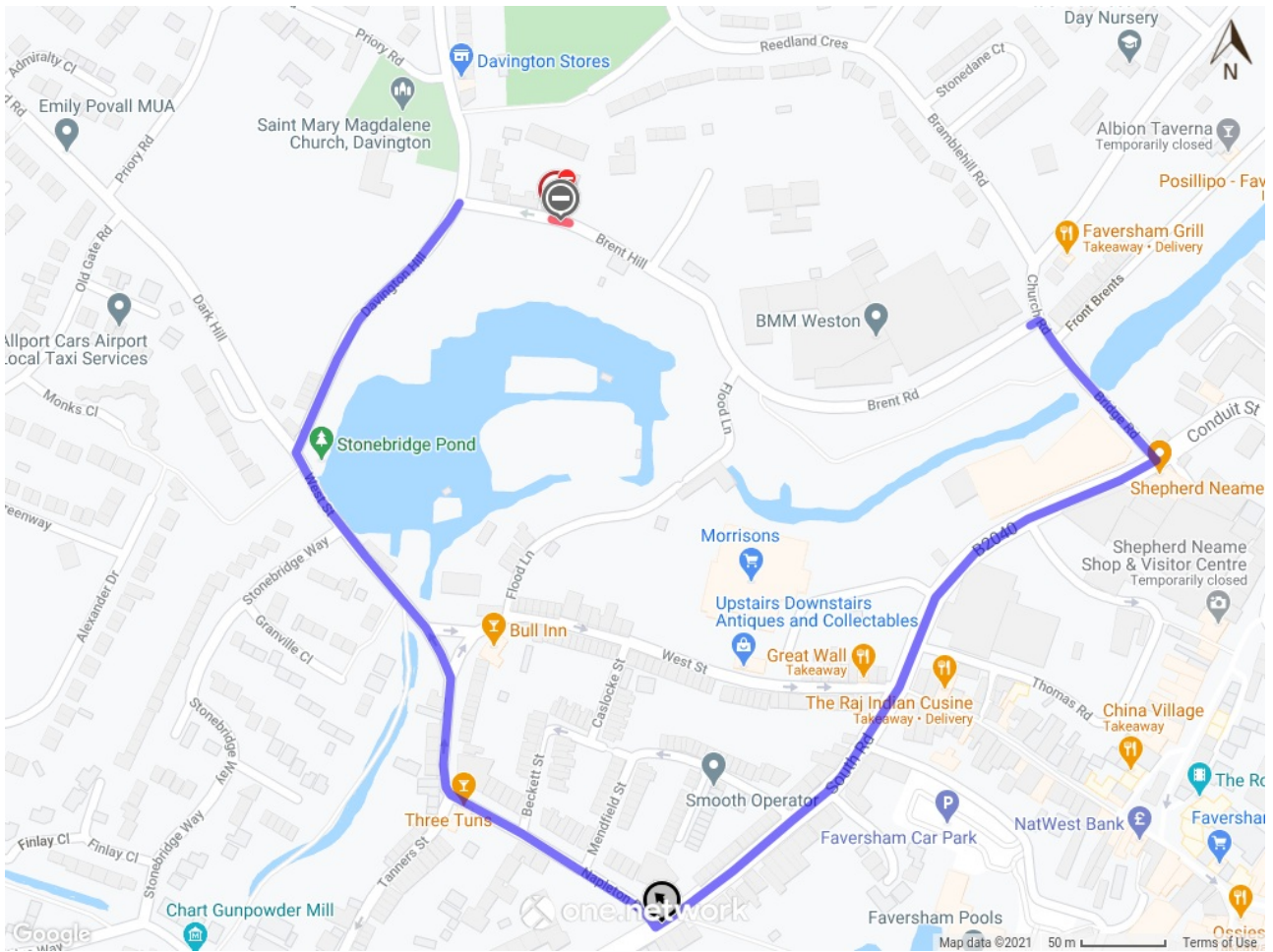
A closure is planned from 9th February 2021, between the hours of 08:00 and 18:00 (excluding weekends), with estimated completion by 15th February 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC3170000000000103895FC - BT). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Brent Hill will be closed in the general vicinity of number 1, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while clearance works are undertaken by BT.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Bridge Road, North Lane, South Road, Napleton Road, Tanners Street, Curtis Way, Davington Hill and vice versa.
