39.	Faversham Youth Budget The Clerk confirmed that £35,000 is remaining in the Faversham Youth Council budget.
40.	Faversham Youth Climate Panel Cllr Williams notes on the Faversham Youth Climate Panel were noted by the Working Group. Cllr Williams confirmed that the Faversham Youth Climate Panel will aim to work/meet with Faversham Environmental Community Groups, to explore voluntary opportunities for young people. As well as create their own youth group to develop projects. It was agreed for the Faversham Youth Climate Panel to sit with the Faversham Climate and Biodiversity Committee. It was suggested by Cllr Irwin that local community groups should be asked what they could bring to the Fun Days.</p> <p>It was suggested by Cllr Williams that the Fun Days should be based on SBC recreation grounds in each Faversham Ward.</p> <p>ACTION – B Williams will produce plans for both ideas, for the working group to discuss further. (Youth Vouchers & Fun Day)</p> <p>ACTION – B Williams will contact the Youth Network Group and other Community Groups to investigate what each member could potentially bring to the Fun Day.</p>
