CANTERBURY ROAD, BOUGHTON UNDER BLEAN

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Canterbury Road, Boughton under Blean will be closed to through traffic, on or after 26th April 2021 for up to 1 day.

The road will be closed between the junctions of Boughton Bypass slip and Stockers Hill.

The alternative route is via Boughton bypass, London Road Harbledown, Upper Harbledown Slip, Dover Road (A2), Dunkirk Slip, Canterbury Road, The Street Boughton and Stockers Hill.

It is anticipated road will be re-open by 2:00pm.

This closure is necessary to enable carriageway patching to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 21 days.
