### Annual Action Plan 2022 to 2023

#### 1. Active Transport and Road Safety

- a. Deliver, and develop further, a town-wide 20mph scheme
- b. Deliver a Local Cycling and Walking Infrastructure Plan (LCWIP)
- c. Continue to encourage cycling and walking through community engagement and events

#### 2. Climate and biodiversity

- a. Encourage biodiversity in areas of local authority ownership, including increasing street planting
- b. Work with Faversham residents to increase biodiversity in their gardens
- c. Continue to promote climate emergency awareness through activities and events
- d. Identify areas for an additional living bus stop and green walls
- e. Continue to work to become a Pesticide Free Town
- f. To identify an area to create a community orchard

#### 3. Neighbourhood Plan and Housing

- a. Continue to develop a neighbourhood plan
- b. Carry out extensive consultation through community engagement
- c. Present a neighbourhood plan which will be successful at referendum
- d. Encourage *truly affordable* housing to be included in the Local Plan

## 4. Youth, Sport and Communities

- a. Develop partnerships with those already identified
- b. Develop a youth engagement plan
- c. Provision of support directly supplied by a youth worker
- d. Support Swale Borough Council's Healthier Action Plan
- e. Provide grants for local community events and groups

## 5. Diversity and Equality

 Support a fairer Faversham by making equality and diversity issues a priority at all levels of the Council as a key part of the decisionmaking process

- b. Ensure that facilities and events are accessible and welcoming to all communities
- c. Foster greater community cohesion by creating a town where difference and diversity is understood, celebrated and valued.
- d. Seek ways to ensure integration with new residents
- e. Seek to implement, where possible, recommendations made by the Electoral Commission or other independent bodies aimed at reducing barriers to standing for election to this council by introducing councillors' allowance.

# 6. Lobby both public and private bodies to gain the best for Faversham, within whose responsibility lies the following

- a. Supporting the development of an opening Creek Bridge and working sluice gates
- b. Supporting the regeneration of the Creek for maritime activities for work and pleasure
- c. Continue engagement with Kent Police, British Transport Police and Swale Borough Council, around the occurrences and perception of anti-social behaviour

## 7. Tourism and Events

- a. Enhance the cultural offer by developing a permanent exhibition of the town's Magna Carta
- b. Develop a detailed marketing plan for Faversham, specifically targeted at increasing use of the Town by residents and increasing numbers of all kinds of visitors and tourists.
