3. Minutes and Matters Arising

Cllr T Martin proposed, seconded by Cllr Reynolds and on being put to the meeting it was **RESOLVED to accept the Minutes of the Heritage Working Group dated 18th August 2021.**

4. VIC Update

Harold Goodwin reported that the frame had been installed for the shutters and painting was underway. Delivery of the shutters was expected in October and the move will follow.

5. Faversham Charters Exhibition

A meeting had taken place to discuss the website and each heritage site will have its own page. The website will match the colours of the exhibition.

The Town Clerk and Facilities Manager had met with representatives of Heritage Watch, who had made various recommendations to increase the security of the building. These included bollards in Back Lane and the rear of the building, shutters to the side door, CCTV camera and additional alarms. The Facilities Manager had provided quotations for some of the works. Swale Borough Council were happy to add the additional camera to their monitored CCTV if the Town Council purchased the camera.

Members were not satisfied with the recommendations and requested that the Town Clerk made enquiries with other security companies, it was agreed she would investigate Salisbury and Lincoln.

It was agreed that Town Council and Faversham Society should work together to promote and encourage residents to list assets on Swale Borough Council's Heritage List.
