Historical Context (From paper produced for the Town Council by L. Young May 2019):

Harvey Drive/Close/Road, etc.

The firm Curtis and Harvey Ltd owned the works (and others in Faversham), taking it over from John Hall & Son Ltd in 1898. There is a Curtis Way in Faversham, but Mr Harvey's contribution to the local industry is not yet commemorated

Alder Drive/Close/Road, etc.

The charcoal used in the making of gunpowder was chiefly made from alder wood. Large quantities of the wood were brought to the works where it was used to make charcoal on-site. Dogwood and willow were also used; there is already a Willow Avenue in Faversham
