(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER JUNE 2021

To allow carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of A299 Thanet Way (Coastbound only), Graveney.

A closure is planned from 21st June 2021, between the hours of 20:00 and 05:00, with estimated completion by 26th June 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE70583759687 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

A299 Thanet Way (Coastbound only) will be closed from Brenley Corner to the junction with Staple Street, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

It will also be necessary to temporarily suspend the weight restrictions on Palmars Cross Hill and Rough Common Road, to allow for diverted traffic.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while carriageway resurfacing works are undertaken by Kent County Council.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Brenley Corner, A2 Boughton Bypass, Dover Road, A2050 Harbledown Bypass, Palmars Cross Hill, Rough Common Road, Whitstable Road, Tile Kiln Hill, Blean Hill, Blean Common, Honey Hill, Pean Hill, Clapham Hill, A299 Thanet Way and vice versa.
