(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2021

To allow tree surgery works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Kit Hill, Selling.

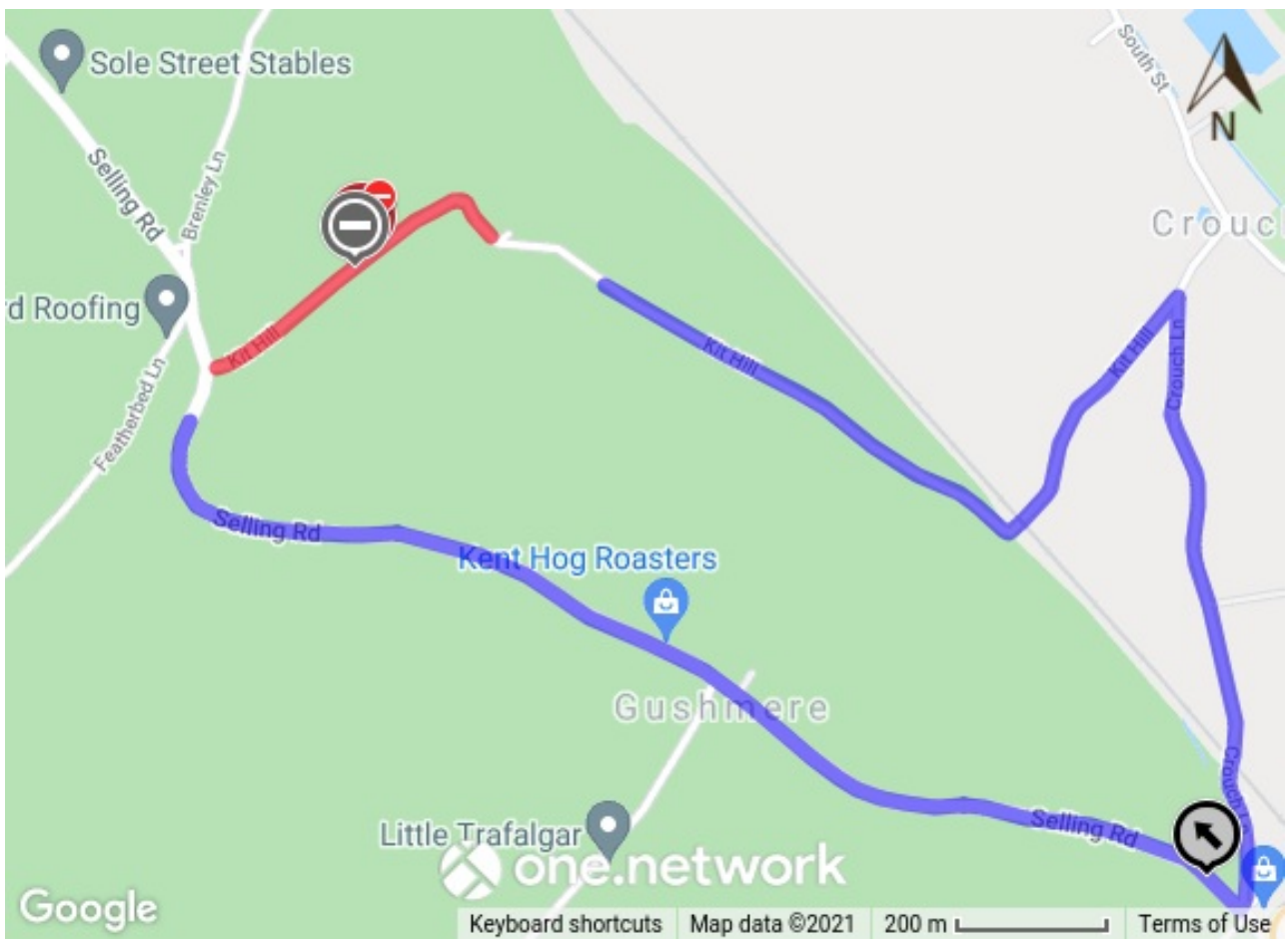
A closure is planned from 5th July 2021, with estimated completion by 9th July 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC111WC4TV15V002 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Kit Hill will be closed from the junction with Selling Road to near Dane Court Farmhouse, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while tree surgery works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Kit Hill, Crouch Lane, Selling Road and vice versa.
