THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2021

To allow cabling works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Norton Lane, Teynham.

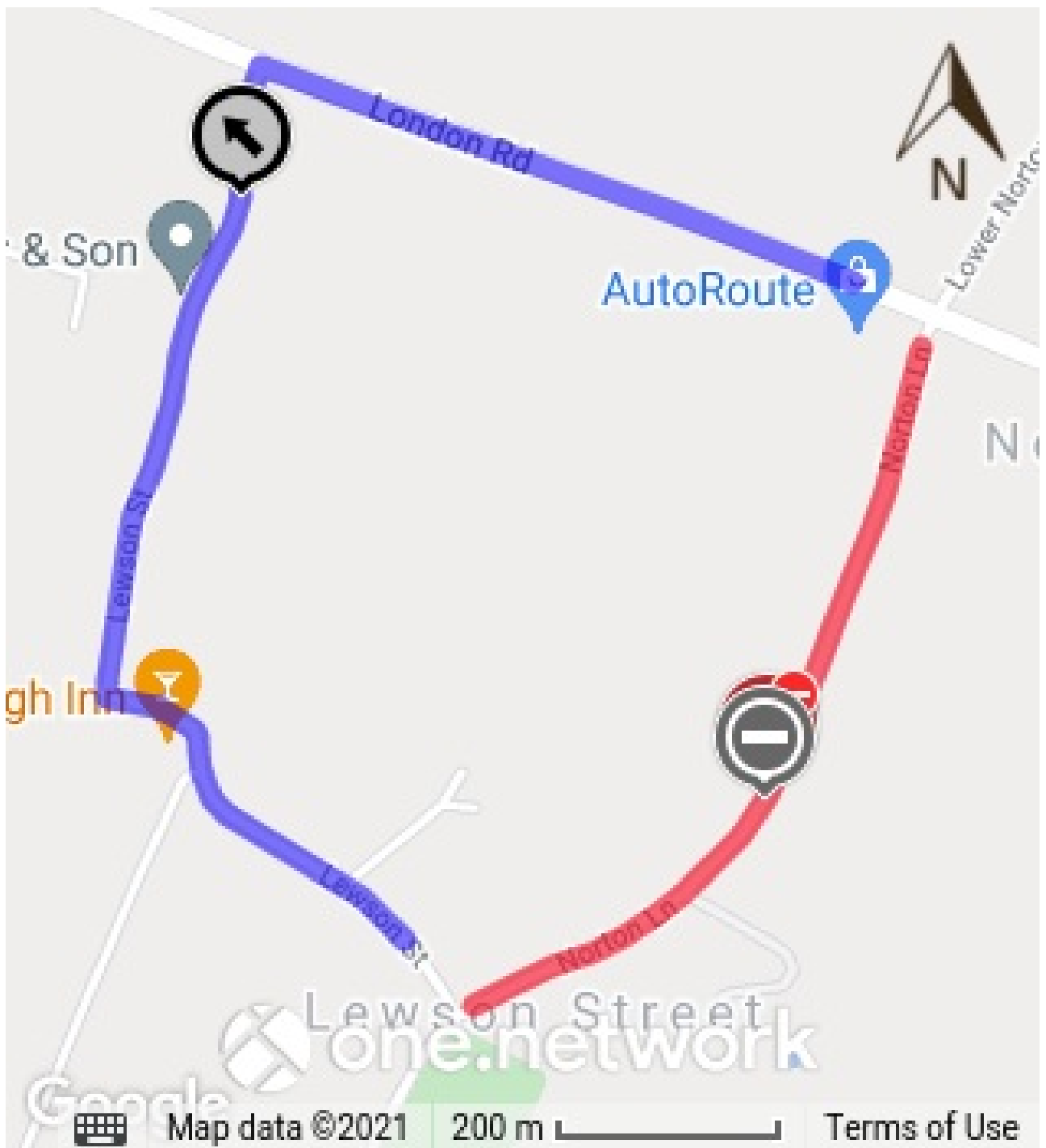
A closure is planned from 5th July 2021, with estimated completion by 16th July 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC111WC2T4P2R001 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Norton Lane will be closed between the junctions with Lewson Street and A2 London Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while cabling works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Lewson Street, A2 London Road and vice versa.
