Plumford Lane, Ospringe
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2021

To allow pole replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Plumford Lane, Ospringe.

A closure is planned from 9th July 2021 for up to 1 day between the hours of 08:00 and 18:00, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC417SE000000090076ONSA - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

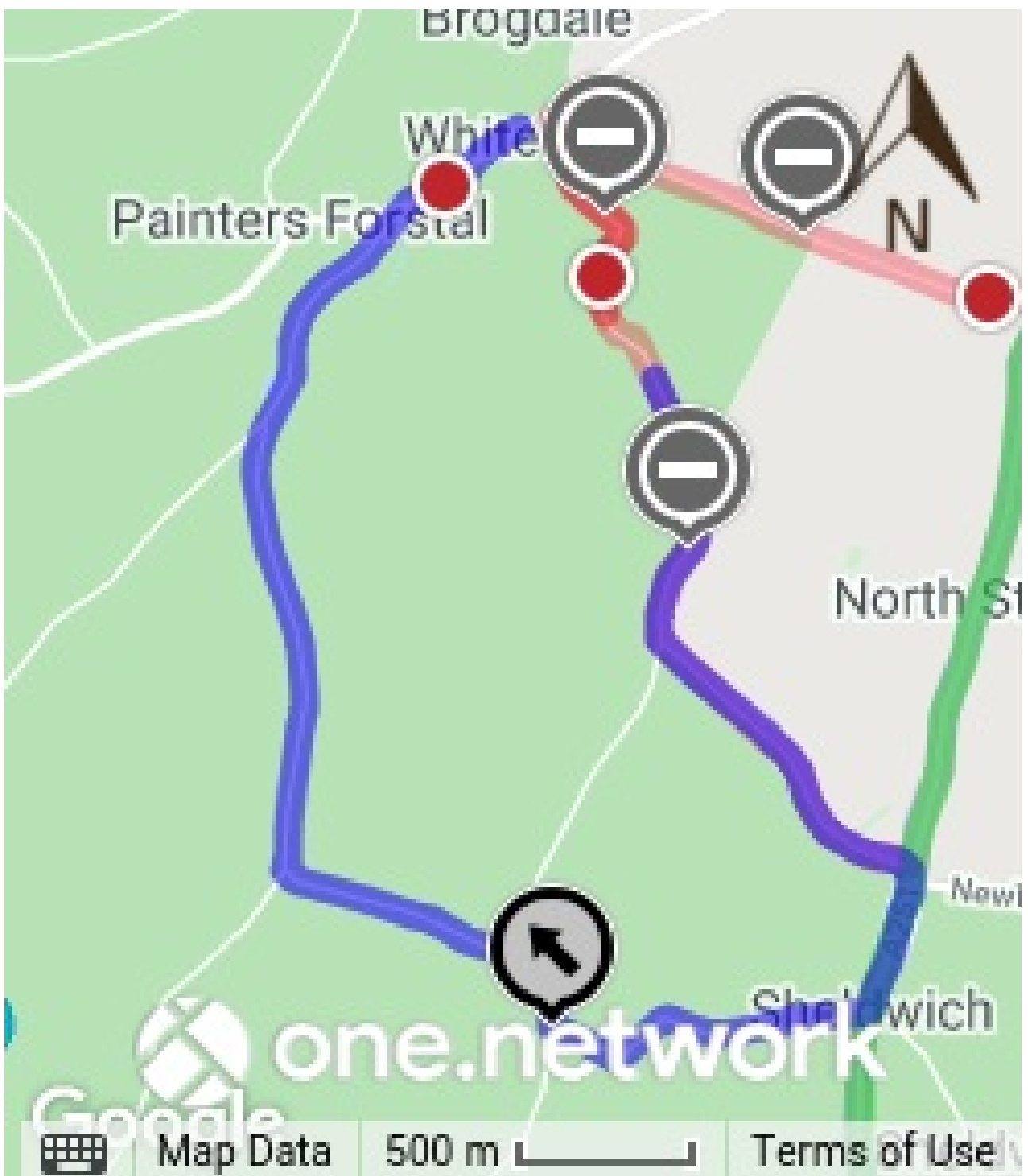
Plumford Lane will be closed from the junction with Eastling Road to outside number 1 Plumford Cottages, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while pole replacement works are undertaken by Openreach.

Please note, if Plumford Lane is shut due to the A251/A2 junction works, this will be lifted to allow the Openreach works to go ahead for the planned date.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Whitehill, Stalisfield Road, Throwley Road, Wilgate Green Road, Old Badgins Road, A251 Ashford Road, Plumford Lane and vice versa.
