**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

TEMPORARY ORDER JUNE 2021

To ensure the proposed diversion route is used whilst works on the A251 are carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on Porters Lane & Plumford Road, Ospringe and Salters Lane & Preston Grove, Faversham.

Closures are planned from 10th June 2021, with estimated completion by 2nd December 2021. The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Porters Lane, Ospringe will be closed between the junctions with A251 Ashford Road and Brogdale Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via A251 Ashford Road, M2, A2 London Road, Canterbury Road, Brogdale Road and vice versa.

The closure will only be in operation when considered necessary and when the signage is displayed on site.

Plumford Road, Ospringe will be closed between the junctions with A251 Ashford Road and Brogdale Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via A251 Ashford Road, M2, A2 London Road, Canterbury Road, Brogdale Road and vice versa.

The closure will only be in operation when considered necessary and when the signage is displayed on site.

Salters Lane, Faversham will be closed between the junctions with A251 Ashford Road and A2 Canterbury Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via A251 Ashford Road, M2, A2 London Road, Canterbury Road and vice versa.

Preston Grove, Faversham will be closed between the junctions with A2 Canterbury Road and Nelson Street, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Preston Lane, The Mall and A2 Canterbury Road.

Residential access will be maintained at all times.

The closures are required to prevent the above roads being used by diverted traffic whilst works on the A251 Ashford Road are undertaken by Kent County Council.
