Historical Context (From paper produced for the Town Council by L. Young May 2019):

Press House Drive- Pressing was part of the process of making gunpowder.

Tramway Drive - Like other gunpowder/explosives works the Marsh Works had it own light railway system on-site, used for transporting both raw ingredients and finished products around the plant. Vestiges of the Marsh Works Tramway can be seen by the east bank of Oare Creek

Evetts Drive - George Evetts was Manager of the Explosives Loading Company of Uplees at the time of the 1916 explosion.

Serpentine Road - "Serpentine Powder" is a historic form of gunpowder.

Gunnery Road - Milled Gunpowder on site was tested using cannons (now on display on phase 1 of our development) and Gunnery is a term for "firing of heavy guns"

Glazing House Drive - Glazing was part of the process of making gunpowder.

Cordite Drive - Cordite is a explosive compound similar to gunpowder.
