**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**  
**THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**TEMPORARY ORDER AUGUST 2021**

To allow clearance works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Brent Hill, Faversham.

A closure is planned from 5th August 2021, between the hours of 08:00 and 18:00, with estimated completion by 9th August 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC3170000000000103895FC - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site displayed on [One.Network](#)

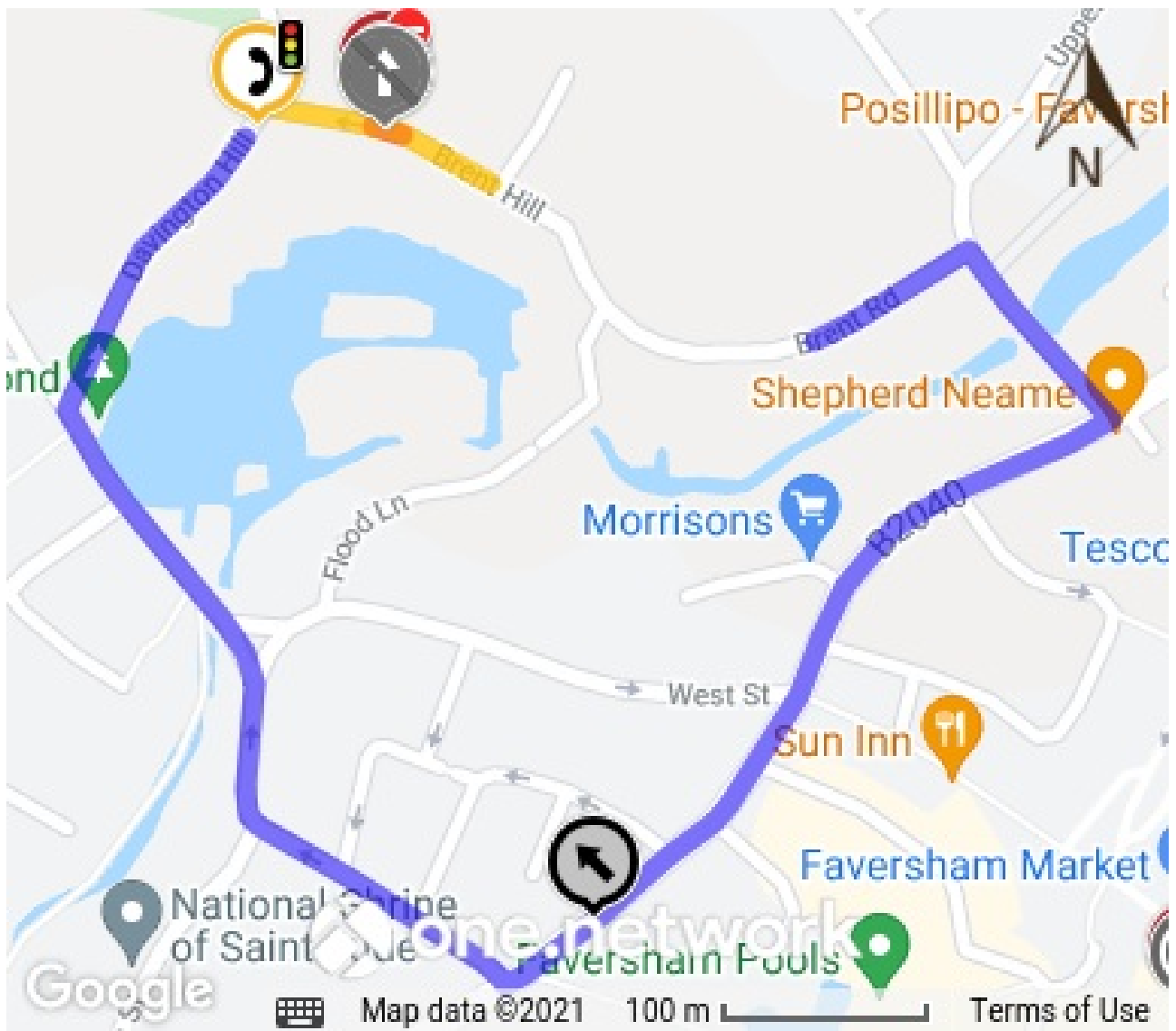
Brent Hill will be closed in the general vicinity of number 1, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The one-way Order on Brent Hill will be temporarily suspended, to allow for access.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while clearance works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Brent Road, Bridge Road, North Lane, South Road, Napleton Road, Tanners Street, Curtis Way and Davington Hill.
