Luton Road, Faversham

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER AUGUST 2021

To allow ducting and chamber works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Luton Road, Faversham.

A closure is planned from 3rd August 2021, between the hours of 08:00 and 18:00, with estimated completion by 5th August 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC31700000000103808FC-1 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on One.Network

Luton Road will be closed in the general vicinity of number 10, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while ducting and chamber works are undertaken by Openreach.

There is no alternative route for this closure. However, residential access will be maintained at all times, when it is safe to do so.
