Stonebridge Way, Faversham
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER AUGUST 2021

To allow frame and cover replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Stonebridge Way, Faversham.

A closure is planned from 2nd August 2021, between the hours of 09:00 and 18:00, with estimated completion by 3rd August 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (LQ001SWAT11253145 - Southern Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

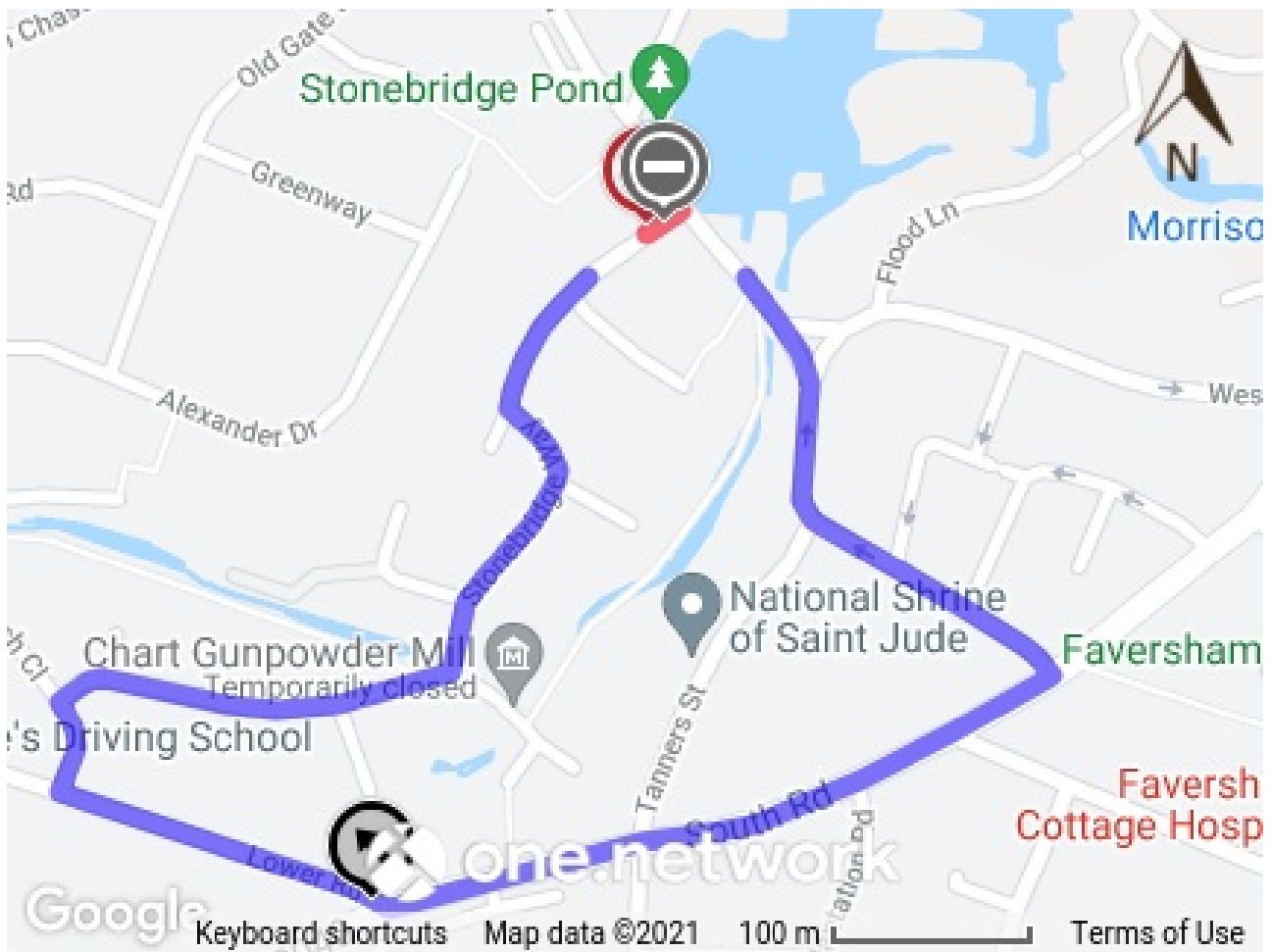
Stonebridge Way will be closed at the junction with Curtis Way, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while frame and cover replacement works are undertaken by Southern Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic travelling on Stonebridge Way is via Stonebridge Way, Beech Close, Lower Road, South Road, Napleton Road, Tanners Street and Curtis Way.

The alternative route for any through traffic travelling on Tanner Street is via Tanners Street, West Street, South Road, Lower Road, Beech Close and Stonebridge Way.
