**TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2021**

**To allow clearing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Water Lane, Ospringe.**

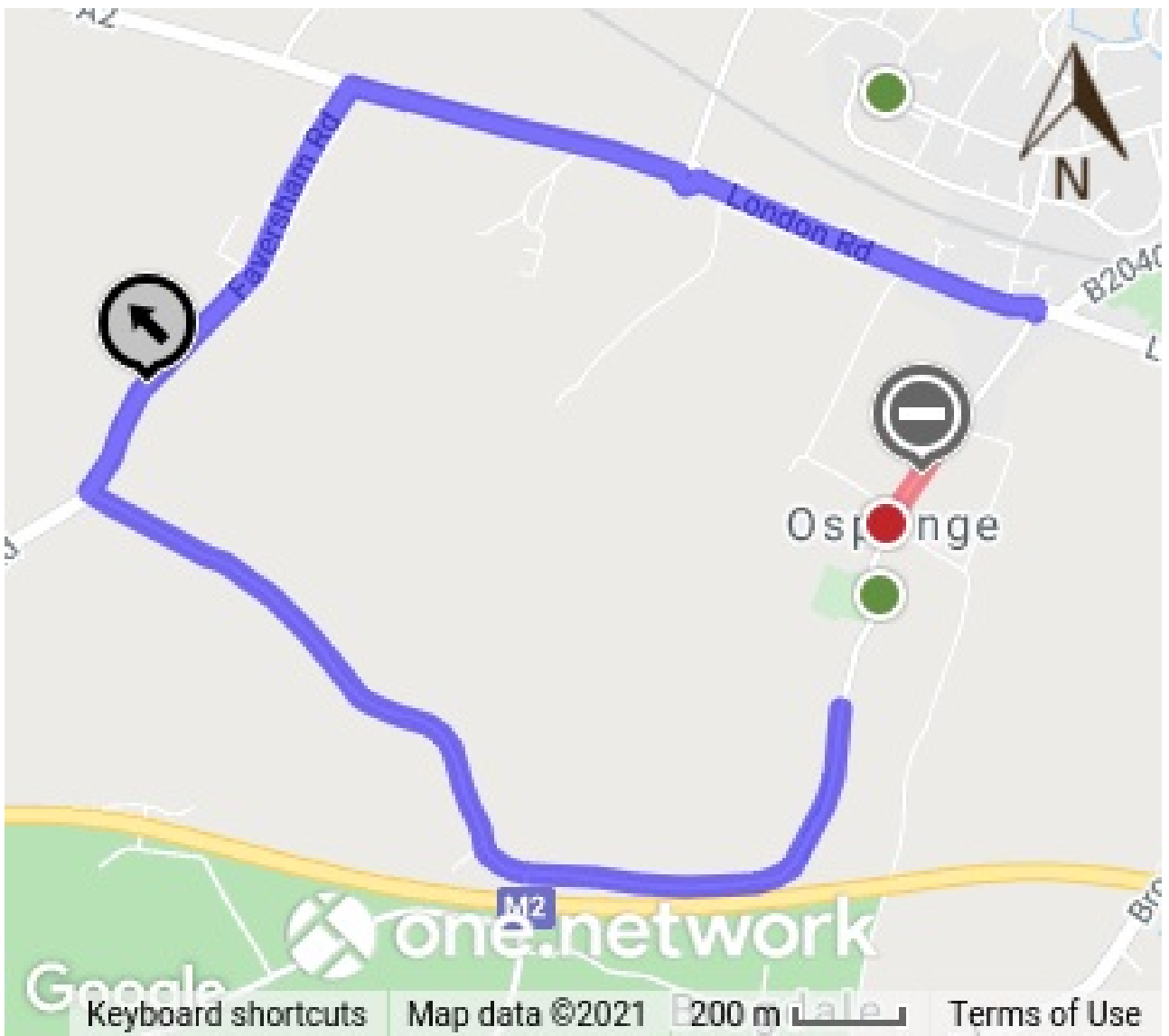
**A closure is planned from 26th July 2021, between the hours of 08:00 and 18:00, with estimated completion by 28th July 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC3170000000000103813FC - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)**

**Water Lane will be closed between the junctions with Vicarage Lane and Mutton Lane, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.**

**The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while clearing works are undertaken by Openreach.**

**The alternative route for any through traffic is via A2 Ospringe Street, London Road, Faversham Road, Coxett Hill, Abbots Hill, Water Lane and vice versa.**
