## (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

## **TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2021**

To allow clearing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Water Lane, Ospringe.


A closure is planned from 26th July 2021, between the hours of 08:00 and 18:00, with estimated completion by 28th July 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC317000000000103813FC - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on <a href="One.Network">One.Network</a>

Water Lane will be closed between the junctions with Vicarage Lane and Mutton Lane, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while clearing works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via A2 Ospringe Street, London Road, Faversham Road, Coxett Hill, Abbots Hill, Water Lane and vice versa.
