- 1. <u>Apologies for Absence</u> Apologies were received from Cllr Barker

- 5. Update on Marketing Plan

Awaiting approval from Facebook to register as a lottery to enable paid advertising. Nextdoor business page has been set up and awaiting approval. There is a banner in Morrisons and they have taken postcards. Tesco has shown an interest and Sainsbury is yet to be contacted.

It was agreed to request a regular ad on Faversham Community Radio. They have already suggested doing a weekly announcement on the numbers. For the present time, advertising will be focused online.

## 6. Protect and Renew Update

Part of the original discussion around renewing the town's assets post-Covid were with event organisers and they had asked for a more cohesive way of working. The idea of an events calendar had been considered which now forms part of the response to SBC's call for ideas. If funding wasn't successful, then the idea would be brought back for consideration of funding.

## 7. Any Other Business

It was agreed at the next meeting to consider whether the lottery should then become a standing item on the Policy & Resources Committee to reduce the number of working groups.
