

Notice of extension of an Order temporarily closing Public Footpaths in the Town of Faversham

In The Borough of Swale

Kent County Council

(Public Footpaths ZF5 (Part) and ZF43 at Faversham Reach and
Waterside Close)

(Prohibition Of Traffic) Temporary Order 2018

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 Section 14(1), As Amended By The
Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991

The Secretary of State for Transport has directed that the Order made by Kent County Council on the 20th March 2018 which came into effect on the 21st March 2018 and was subsequently extended until the 21st September 2021, the effect of which was to prohibit all public traffic from Public Footpaths ZF5 and ZF43, has been extended for a further 2 years, until the 21st September 2023.

The paths are closed between a point on Crab Island, NGR TR 0174 6192 and Public Footpath ZF32

The alternative route is via Public Footpaths ZF42, ZF5, ZF1 and ZF32.
