50. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

51. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

There were no declarations of interest.

52. MINUTES

It was proposed by Cllr T Martin seconded by Cllr J Irwin and on being put to the meeting it was ***RESOLVED to approve the Minutes of the Meeting of Faversham Town Council Planning Committee held on 15th November 2021.***

53. PLANNING SCHEDULE

The Planning Schedule dated 15th November 2021 was noted.

54. PLANNING APPLICATIONS

It was: ***RESOLVED that recommendations be sent to Kent County Council (Kent County Council) and Swale Borough Council (SBC) as set out Planning Schedule 6th November 2021.***

55. PUBLIC FOOTPATH ZF7 and RESTRICTED BYWAY ZF4A

The meeting received the Pre-order Consultation on Public Footpath ZF7 and Restricted Byway ZF4A.

It was proposed by Cllr T Martin seconded by Cllr H Perkin and on being put to the meeting it was ***RESOLVED to Support the amendments to the definitive map.***

Further, Members commented that they were disappointed that the error had been made on the Definitive Map and sought reassurance that the situation will not reoccur if future developments necessitate further diversions.

PUBLIC QUESTIONS

Martin Collins raised concerns regarding 21/506027/FULL. As a resident on Whitstable Road he was directly effected by the music at St Saviours Church, on two occasion in November he had recorded music being played in excess of the 37db set by SBC in the Planning Decision Notice dated 15th October and had reported to SBC.

The nature of the business operating at St Saviours had changed, and it was now being advertised as a music venue, rather than a daytime café

Mr Collins asked for the noise to be limited.
