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| 1. | <p><u>Apologies for absence</u></p> <p>Apologies were received from G Wade</p> | |
| 2. | <p><u>Declarations of interest</u></p> <p>There were no new declarations of interest.</p> | |
| 3. | <p><u>Minutes of 18th January</u></p> <p>The Minutes of the meeting held on 18th January were approved as an accurate record. These minutes had been presented to Full Council on 7th February.</p> | |
| 4. | <p><u>Discussion on Matters Arising from Minutes of 18th January</u></p> <p>Minute 4 (Matters Arising (15th November)) – It was noted that JI and KB had attended a virtual meeting with JP, JF and AW from SBC on 28th January. HB from Urban Vison had also been in attendance. It had been acknowledged there had been a delay in confirming the housing number to be allocated in the NHP (219). SBC had agreed to offer continued support to the NHP SG. Since the meeting the SG had received confirmation that Wallers Road (former play area) was not for sale or available for development. Members were reminded that the site had been included in the LGS consultation.</p> <p>It was noted that Urban Vision was now providing project management support. A bi-weekly meeting would take place with HB, KB and JI, which other members of the SG were welcome to attend.</p> <p>Minute 6 (Brownfield Sites 18th January) – HP confirmed that the first tranche of funding had closed. SBC had been asked to confirm when the second tranche would open.</p> | |

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| 5 | <p><u>Site Selection</u></p> <p>The SG noted that the Site Selection – Public Consultation had been launched on 14th February. There had been a technical issue with the consultation and it had been temporarily removed from the Town Council website. [Office Note: The consultation had been relaunched on 1st March with an extended deadline to 28th March]</p> <p>It was noted that an exhibition would be held at the Town Hall during the public consultation.</p> <p>ACTION: Doodle Poll to be circulated to recruit volunteers to man the exhibition</p> <p>HG enquired if there was an update from KCC on the availability of Kiln Court. It was noted that confirmation had not been received, despite being pursued by County Councillor A Hook and FTC. It was agreed that it would be helpful of others pursued KCC on the matter.</p> | AB |
