(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER OCTOBER 2021

To allow overhead cabling works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Wildmarsh Road, Luddenham.


A closure is planned from 26th October 2021 at 09:30, with estimated completion by 26th October 2021 at 15:30, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC008OGEA51009779-03 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on One.Network

Wildmarsh Road will be closed outside Elverton Bungalow to outside The Old Rectory, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while overhead cabling works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Elverton Lane, Lower Road, Bysing Wood Road, Luddenham Hill and vice versa.
