**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

TEMPORARY ORDER OCTOBER 2021

To allow desilting and repair works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Rawling Street, Milstead & Slough Road, Rodmersham.

A closure is planned from 11th October 2021, with estimated completion by 29th October 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC111WC6K894G001 & BC111WC6K894G002- Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signs showing and/or displayed on [One.Network](#)

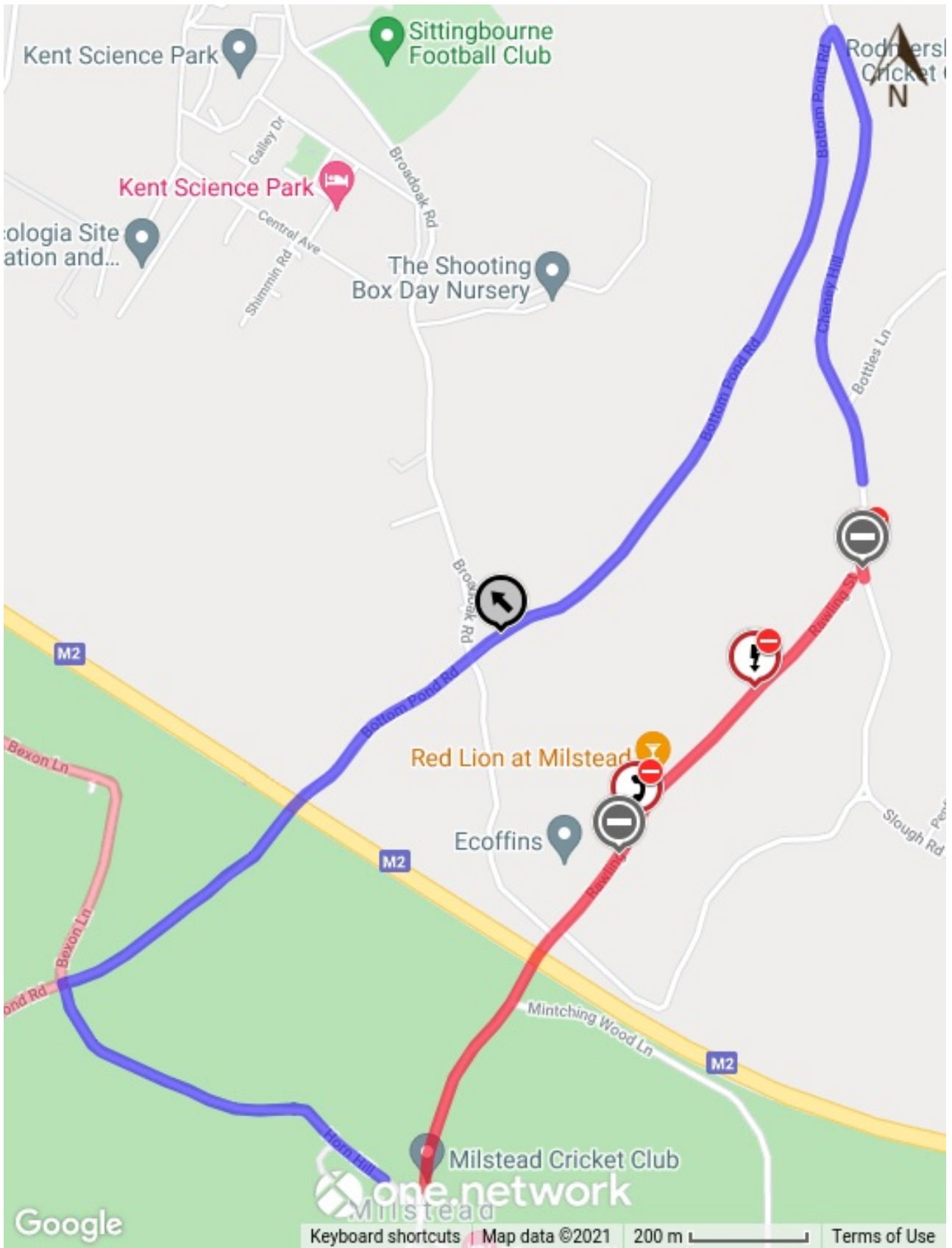
Rawling Street will be closed between the junctions with Horn Hill and Cheney Hill, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

Slough Road will be closed between the junctions with Rawling Street and Cheney Hill, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while desilting and repair works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Horn Hill, Bottom Pond Road, Cheney Hill and vice versa.
