THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER OCTOBER 2021

To allow utility works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Almshouse Road, Throwley Forstal.

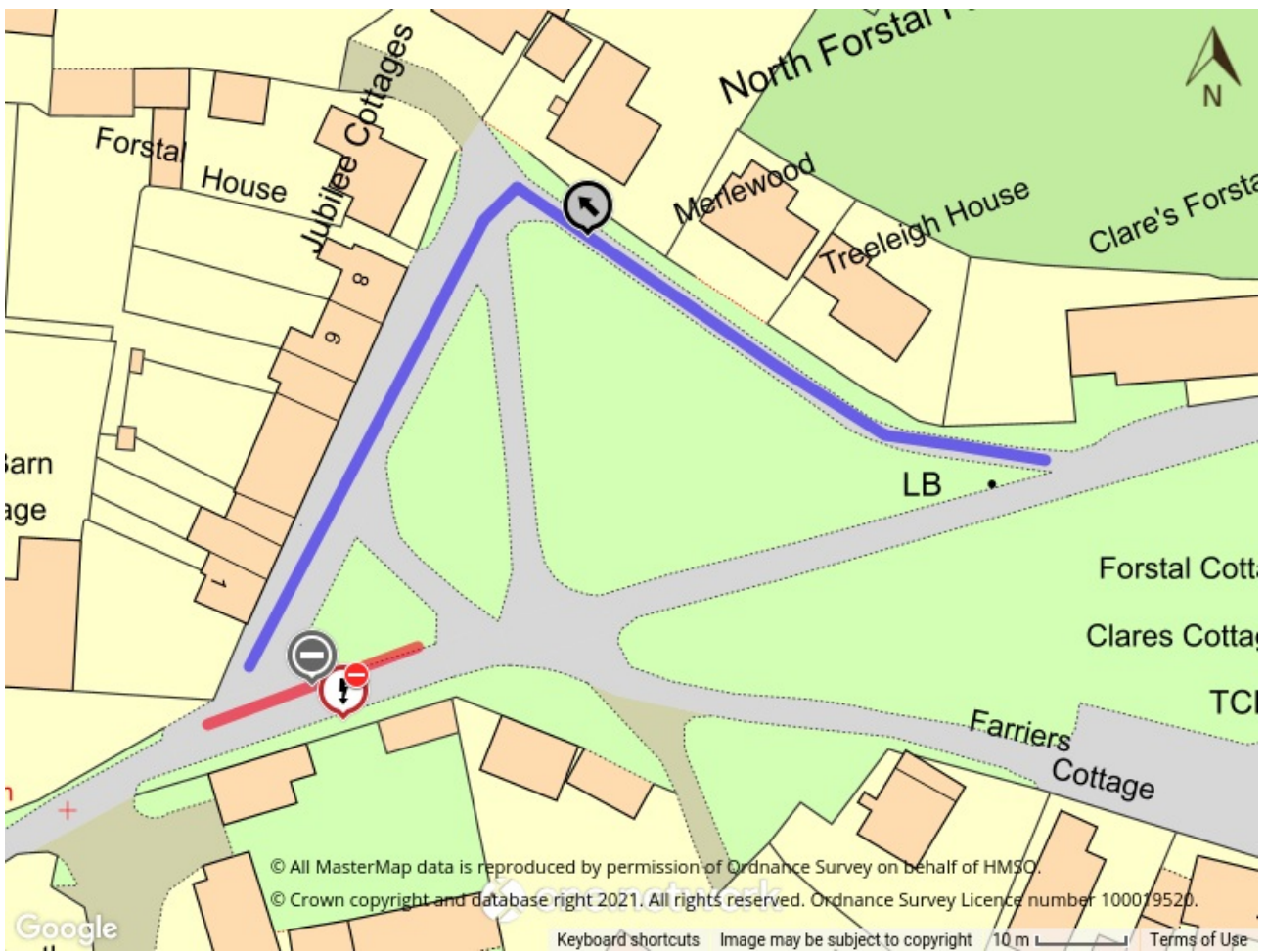
A closure is planned from 19th October 2021, with estimated completion by 25th October 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (KZ50020503416 - UK Power Networks & EB00928552163 - South East Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Almshouse Road will be closed outside land adjacent Forge Farm, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while road crossing and joint bay works are undertaken by UK Power Networks & while water main connection works are undertaken by South East Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Almshouse Road and vice versa.
