**Canterbury Road, Dunkirk**  
**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**  
**THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**TEMPORARY ORDER OCTOBER 2021**

To allow vegetation works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Canterbury Road, Dunkirk.

A closure is planned from 25th October 2021, with estimated completion by 29th October 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE40113013972-01 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

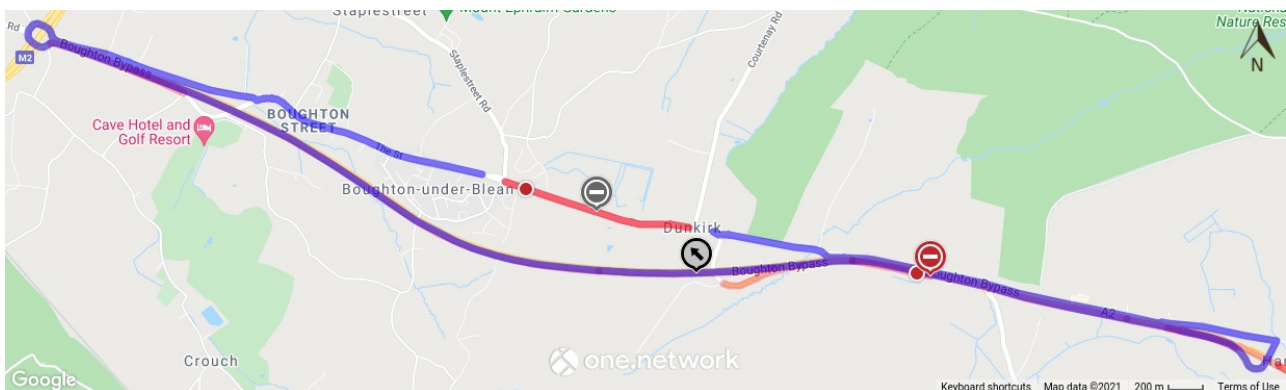
Canterbury Road will be closed between the junctions with Horselees Road and Courtenay, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while vegetation works are undertaken by Kent County Council.

The alternative route for traffic travelling eastbound is via The Street, Stockers Hill, Canterbury Road, A2 Boughton Bypass westbound, Boughton Bypass eastbound, London Road (Upper Harbledown), Upper Harbledown slip, A2 Dover Road (westbound), Dunkirk Slip Westbound and Canterbury Road.

The alternative route for traffic travelling westbound is via Canterbury Road, A2 Boughton Bypass (Eastbound), London Road (Upper Harbledown), Upper Harbledown slip, A2 Dover Road (Westbound), A2 Boughton Bypass (Westbound), A2 Boughton Bypass (Eastbound) and Canterbury Road.
