**TEMPORARY ORDER OCTOBER 2021**

To allow overhead cabling works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Christophers Row, Lynsted.

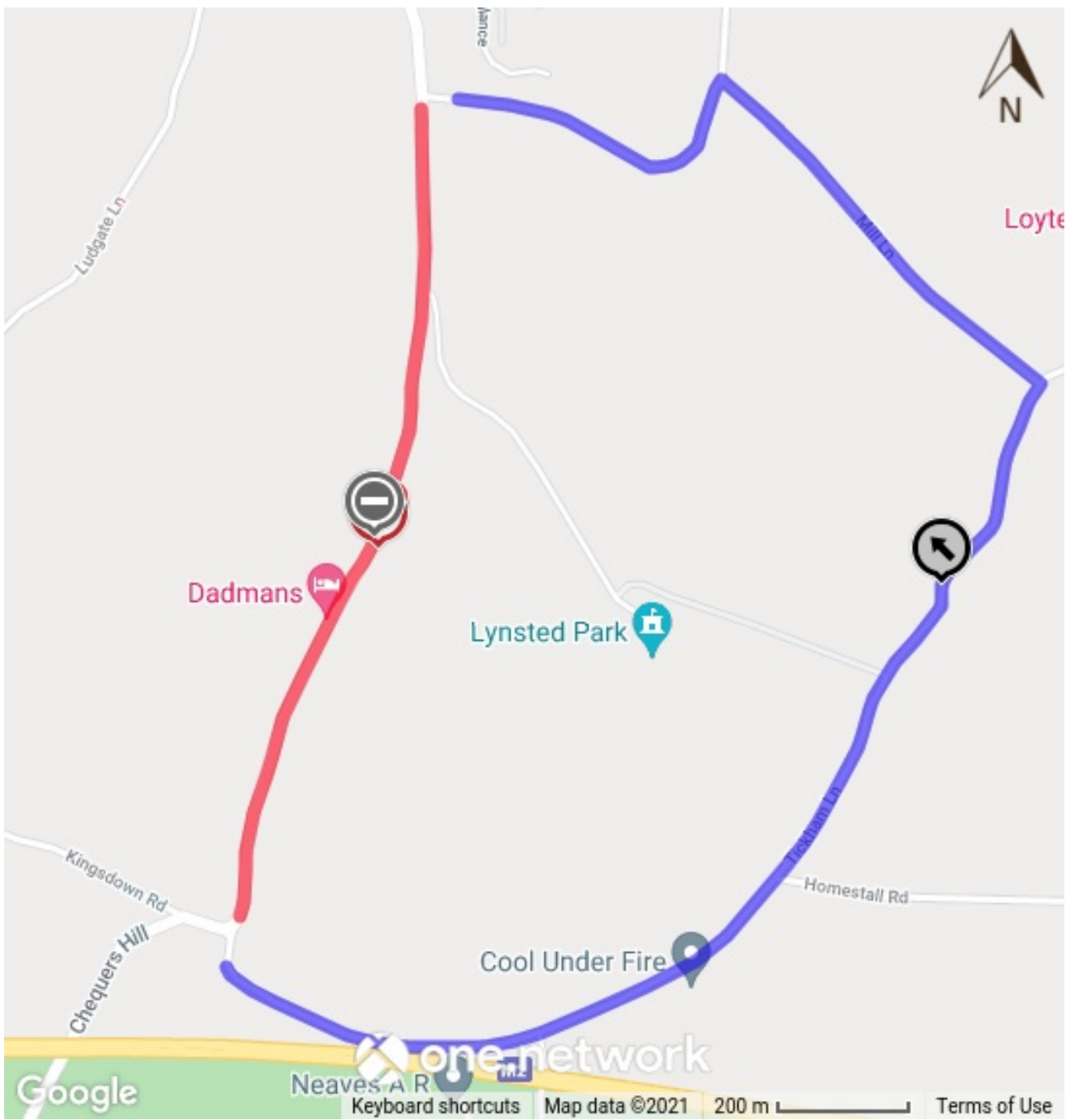
A closure is planned from 19th October 2021 at 09:30, with estimated completion by 19th October 2021 at 15:30, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC008OGEA67257914A-03 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Christophers Row will be closed between the junctions with Toll Road and Kingsdown Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while overhead cabling works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Toll Road, Mill Lane, Tickham Lane, Sharsted Road and vice versa.
