Stalisfield Road, Eastling
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER OCTOBER 2021

To allow cabling works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Stalisfield Road, Eastling.

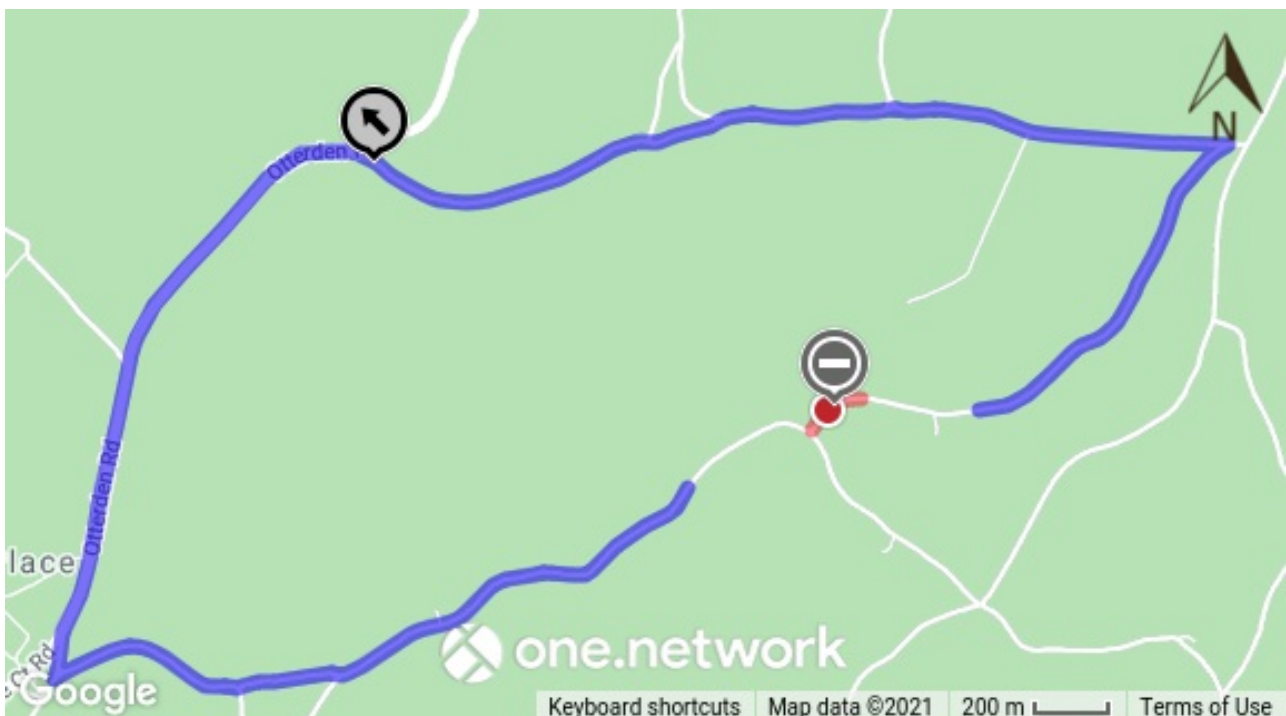
A closure is planned from 27th October 2021, with estimated completion by 9th November 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC111WC9D3L0N001-02 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Stalisfield Road will be closed from outside Huntingfield Cottage to the junction with Holbeam Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while cabling works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Stalisfield Road, Rigshill Road, Otterden Road, Kettle Hill Road and vice versa.
