A251 ASHFORD ROAD, FAVERSHAM

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that A251 Ashford Road, Faversham will be closed to through traffic, on or after 1st November 2021 for up to 10 nights.

The road will be closed between the junction of A2 Canterbury Road and the entrance to the Fire Station.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via A251 Ashford Road, M2 Junction 6 To Junction 7 On Slip, M2, M2 Junction 7 From Junction 6 Off Slip, Brenley Corner, A2 M2 J7 Roundabout, A2 London Road and Canterbury Road.

Non motorway traffic will be guided by traffic management operative on site.

It is planned that the road will be closed between 19:30 hrs and 04:00 hrs each night.

This closure is necessary to enable carriageway resurfacing to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 21 days.
