(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER DECEMBER 2021

To allow replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Brent Hill, Faversham.

A closure is planned from 13th December 2021, between the hours of 08:00 and 17:00, with estimated completion by 14th December 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (LQ001SWAT11384381-03 - Southern Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Brent Hill will be closed in the general vicinity of BMM, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while replacement works are undertaken by Southern Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Bridge Road, North Lane, South Road, Napleton Road, Tanners Street, Curtis Way and Davington Hill.
