(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER NOVEMBER 2021

To allow joint bay and road crossing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Teynham Street, Teynham.

A closure is planned from 23rd November 2021, with estimated completion by 24th November 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (KZ50057715693-01 - UK Power Networks). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signs showing and/or displayed on [One.Network](#)

Teynham Street will be closed in the general vicinity of Banks Farm Cottage, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while joint bay and road crossing works are undertaken by UK Power Networks.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Marsh Road, Deerton Street, Lower Road, Conyer Road and vice versa.
