THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER DECEMBER 2021

To allow frame and cover replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of The Street, Boughton Under Blean.

A closure is planned from 7th December 2021 at 19:00, with estimated completion by 8th December 2021 at 05:00, or where stated on a valid Permit (LQ003SWAT11424671-02 - Southern Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

The Street will be closed in the general vicinity of number 177, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while frame and cover replacement works are undertaken by Southern Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Stockers Hill, Canterbury Road, A2 Boughton Bypass, Brenley Corner, A299 Thanet Way, Thanet Way Slip, Whitstable Road, Staple Street Road, Staple Street, Staplestreet Road, The Street and vice versa.
