(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER DECEMBER 2021

To allow pole test works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Throwley Road, Throwley.

A closure is planned from 13th December 2021 at 09:30, with estimated completion by 13th December 2021 at 15:30, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC008PTMS154435-01 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on One.Network

Throwley Road will be closed between the junctions with Workhouse Road and Almshouse Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while pole test works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Throwley Road, Throwley, Workhouse Road and vice versa.
