(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER MARCH 2022

To allow pole replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Athelstan Road, Faversham.

A closure is planned from 1st March 2022 at 08:00, with estimated completion by 1st March 2022 at 18:00, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC417SEPOL0000175726ONSA-01 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on <u>One.Network</u>

Athelstan Road will be closed from outside number 14 to the junction with B2041 Forbes Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while pole replacement works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Kingsnorth Road, Belmont Road, B2041 Forbes Road and vice versa.
