(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER FEBRUARY 2022

To allow overhead structure works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Petts Dane Road, Eastling.

A closure is planned from 23rd February 2022, between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30, with estimated completion by 25th February 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC008WCLM876W01STH-01 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Petts Dane Road will be closed between the junctions with Kettle Hill Road and Stalisfield Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while overhead structure works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Kettle Hill Road, Stalisfield Road and vice versa.
