(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER MARCH 2022

To allow maintenance works to be carried out on apparatus, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Newhouse Lane, Sheldwich.

A closure is planned from 21st March 2022, between the hours of 08:00 and 18:00, with estimated completion by 22nd March 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC31700000000138161RFB2-01 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Newhouse Lane will be closed 165 metres west of Newhouse Farm Cottages, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while maintenance works on apparatus are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Winding Hill, Highbens Hill, Selling Street, The Street, Selling Road, Brenley Lane, A2 Canterbury Road, A251 Ashford Road, Newhouse Lane and vice versa.
