SOUTH ROAD, FAVERSHAM

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that South Road, Faversham will be closed to through traffic, on or after 7th March 2022 for up to 2 nights.

The road will be closed between the junctions of Albion Road and North Road.

The alternative route is via Ospringe Road, Ospringe Street, London Road, Love Lane, Whitstable Road, East Street, Crescent Road, Court Street, Quay Lane and North Road.

It is planned that the road will be closed between 20:00 hrs and 05:00 hrs each night.

This closure is necessary to enable carriageway repairs to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
