Notice is hereby given that KENT COUNTY COUNCIL intends to make the above Order under sections 1(1), 2 (1) to (3), 3 (2), 4 (1) and (2), 32 (1), 35 (1), 44, 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter called "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby propose to make the following order:-

The effect of the proposed named Order will be to install waiting restrictions in the following lengths of road (in this part of the notice DYL's means double yellow lines) waiting to be prohibited at any time.

Roads in Faversham in the Borough of Swale

DARK HILL - DYL – (1) On the northeast side from a point 35 metres northwest of its junction with Davington Hill for a distance of 20 metres in a north westerly direction. (2) On the southwest side from a point 25 meters northwest of its junction with Davington Hill for a distance of 43 metres in a north westerly direction. **WEST STREET – DYL** (1) On north side extend the existing lines to a point 29 metres northwest of the northwest boundary of Twyman's Mill. (2) On the northeastern side from a point 18 metres from the centre line of Davington Hill reduce the lines to 13 in a south easterly direction. (3) On the south side extend the existing lines to a point 29 metres northwest of the northwest boundary of Twyman's Mill. (4) On the southwest side from its junction with Dark Hill for a distance of 8 metres in a south easterly direction.

The Kent County Council, acting as the Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers and under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 44, 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby propose to make the following Order:-

A – This Order may be cited as “The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Borough of Swale) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Amendment No.30” ('this Order') and shall come into force on the ** day of ***** 2022.

B - “The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Borough of Swale) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2019” ('the Order of 2019') shall have effect as though-

FIRST SCHEDULE

Roads in Faversham in the Borough of Swale

The following to be inserted to the First Schedule of the Order of 2019 in place of the existing entry:-

DARK HILL

(1) On the north-eastern side

(a) from its junction with Davington Hill for a distance of 3 metres in a north westerly direction;

~~(b) from a point 5 metres northwest of the rear boundary of 1 Davington Hill for a distance of 19 metres in a north-westerly direction;~~

(b) from a point 35 metres northwest of the junction with Davington Hill for a distance of 20 metres in a north westerly direction.

(2) On the south-western from its junction with West Street for a distance of 17 metres in a north westerly direction. ~~side from a point in line with the south-eastern boundary of 1 Dark Hill to a point in line with the boundary of 3/5 Dark Hill.~~

WEST STREET

(1) On both sides between its Junctions with Market Street and North Lane.
