ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, acting as Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 81, 82, 83 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act') as amended, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

REVOCATION, MODIFICATION AND AMENDMENTS

The "Kent County Council (Various Roads, The Borough of Swale) (20mph, 30mph, 40mph, 50mph Speed Limits and Derestricted Roads) Consolidation Order 2012" ("the Order of 2012") be amended as follows.

In Schedule 4 of the Order of 2012 the following entries as in the Table below shall be deleted from the Schedule.

Item No	Road Name	Parish	Description
17	ASHFORD ROAD	FAVERSHAM	From its junction with Plumford Lane for a distance of 10 metres.
18	ASHFORD ROAD	FAVERSHAM	From a point 212 metres north of its junction with Salters Lane northwards for a distance of 92 metres.
19	ASHFORD ROAD	FAVERSHAM	From a point 304 metres north of its junction with Salters Lane northwards for a distance of 246 metres.

In Schedule 3 of the Order of 2012 the following entry as in the Table below shall be added to the Schedule.

Item No	Road Name	Parish	Description
120	ASHFORD ROAD	FAVERSHAM	From its junction with Canterbury Road (A2) to a point 90 metres south of its junction with Tettenhall Way.

In Schedule 4 of the Order of 2012 the following entry as in the Table below shall be added to the Schedule.

Item No	Road Name	Parish	Description
17	ASHFORD ROAD	FAVERSHAM	From a point 212 metres north of its junction with Salters Lane to a point 90 metres south of its junction with Tettenhall Way.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Kent County Council hereby make an Order under Sections 81, 82, 83 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order would be to reduce the 40MPH speed limit and replace with a 30mph speed limit on the following length of road in Faversham, Swale:-

ASHFORD ROAD (A251) – From its junction with Canterbury Road (A2) to a point 90 metres south of its junction with Tettenhall Way.

The Order was made on 5 May 2022 and its provisions will come into effect on 6 May 2022.

A full statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order, a plan indicating the location and the effect and a copy of any other Orders which will be amended by the made Order may be examined at Kent Highways, Transportation & Waste, Ashford Highway Depot, Henwood Industrial Estate, Unit 4 Javelin Way, Ashford, Kent TN24 8AD by appointment booked through tro@kent.gov.uk or viewed online from 6 May 2022 at www.kent.gov.uk/highwaysconsultations

Anyone may, by application to the High Court within 6 weeks of the date of publication of this Notice, challenge the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained in them on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or any instrument made thereunder, or that there has been a failure to comply with any statutory requirement to the Orders.
