(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER JUNE 2022

To allow underground structure works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Preston Street, Faversham.

A closure is planned from 21st June 2022 at 20:00, with estimated completion by 22nd June 2022 at 05:00, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC00821JUNNDKCX453-02 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on <u>One.Network</u>

Preston Street will be closed at the junction with Stone Street, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while underground structure works are undertaken by Openreach.

There is no alternative route for this closure. However Gatemen will be on site, at both closure points (East Street junction Newton Road and Court street junction Crescent Road), to allow safe access.
