Stalisfield Road, Stalisfield
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER JUNE 2022

To allow cabling works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Stalisfield Road, Stalisfield.

A closure is planned from 16th June 2022 at 08:00, with estimated completion by 16th June 2022 at 18:00, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC11700000000202334L2C1-01 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Stalisfield Road will be closed from outside Belvedere to outside Pekins House, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while cabling works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Stalisfield Road, Hillside Road, Church Road, Pettfield Hill Road and vice versa.
