(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER JUNE 2022

To allow road crossing and joint bay works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Staplestreet Road, Dunkirk.

A closure is planned from 13th June 2022, with estimated completion by 17th June 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (KZ50027749248-01 - UK Power Networks). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Staplestreet Road will be closed in the general vicinity of Thatch Cottage, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while road crossing and joint bay works are undertaken by UK Power Networks.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Staplestreet Road, Staple Street, Staple Street Road, Whitstable Road, Homestall Lane, Brenley Corner, Boughton Bypass, Canterbury Road, Stockers Hill, The Street and vice versa.
