**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**  
**THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**TEMPORARY ORDER JUNE 2022**

To allow drainage survey works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Tanners Street, Faversham.

A closure is planned from 27th June 2022, with estimated completion by 29th June 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE70711306215-01 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Tanners Street will be closed between the junctions with Napleton Road and West Street, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while drainage survey works are undertaken by Kent County Council.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via B2040 South Road, Lower Road and Stonebridge Way.
