THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER JUNE 2022

To allow a layby closure to be in place to support Operation Brock, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on the London bound layby on A299 Thanet Way, Graveney.

A layby closure is planned from 25th June 2022, with estimated completion by 25th June 2023. The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

The London bound Layby will be closed on A299 Thanet Way, Graveney 700 metres north of the Brenley Corner junction, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while Operation Brock is enforced by Kent County Council.
